Notification of Asbestos Management

The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), signed into law on October 22, 1986, requires all local education agencies to identify asbestos-containing materials (ACM) in their school buildings and take appropriate actions to control the release of asbestos fibers. We are required to notify our workers and building occupants or their legal guardians (parents, teachers and employee organization) at least once each school year about inspections, response actions and post-response activities, including periodic re-inspection and surveillance activities which are planned or in progress.

A copy of the management plan is located in the school office and in the Facilities Director's Office located at 23 Highland Ave. and is available for inspection without cost during normal working hours.
